# Survey Results

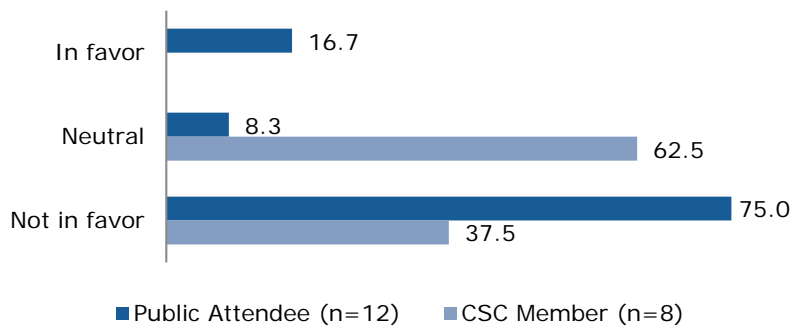

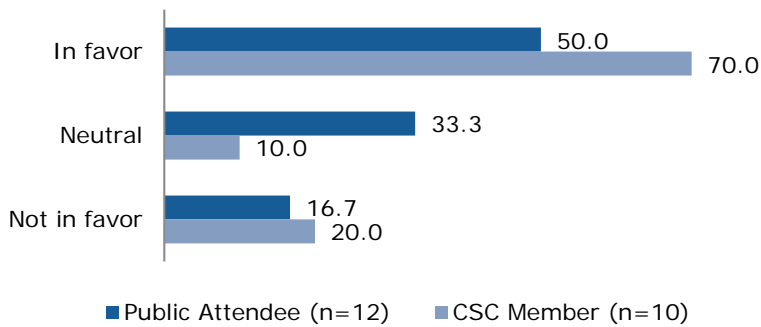
## Exhibit 2. Overall, the air quality in the Calexico-Heber-El Centro corridor is good today.



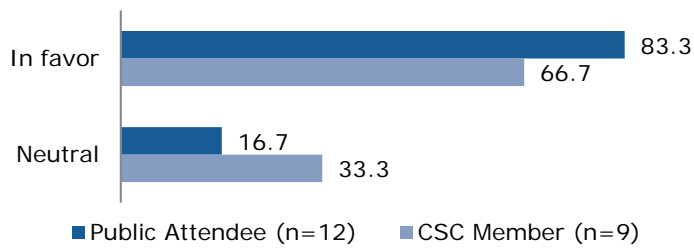

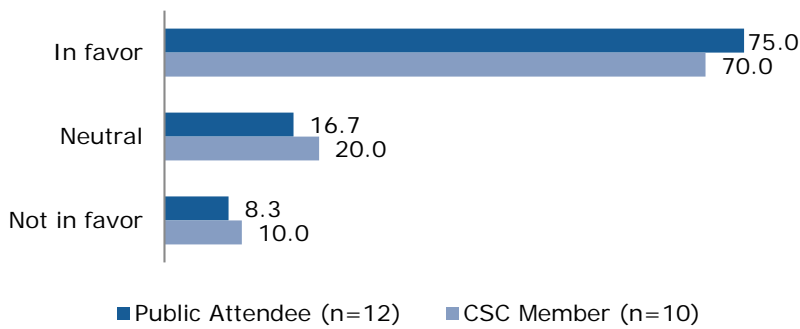

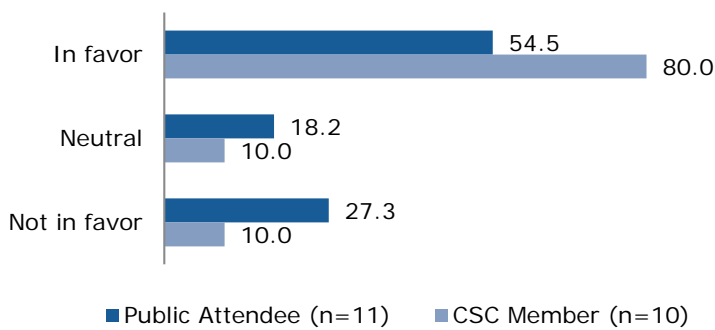

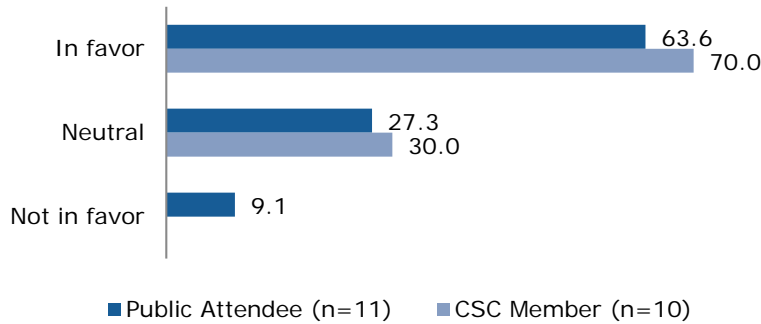

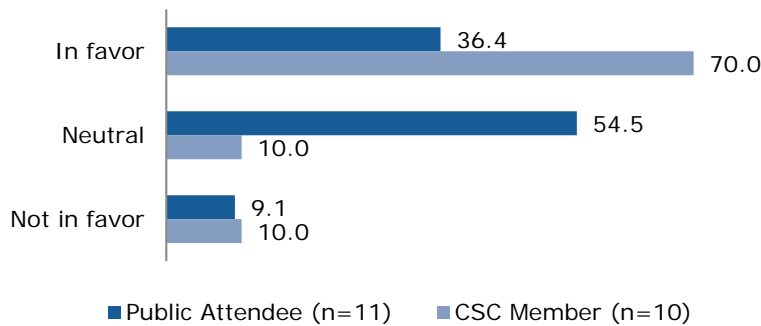

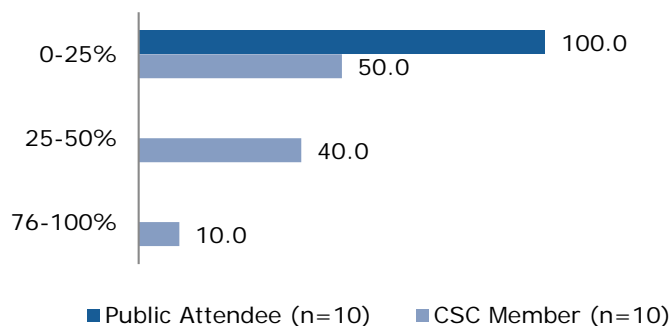
**Exhibit 8. Please rate your level of favorability with the following mitigation strategies aimed at mitigating the impacts of ongoing air pollution: *Green-space projects***



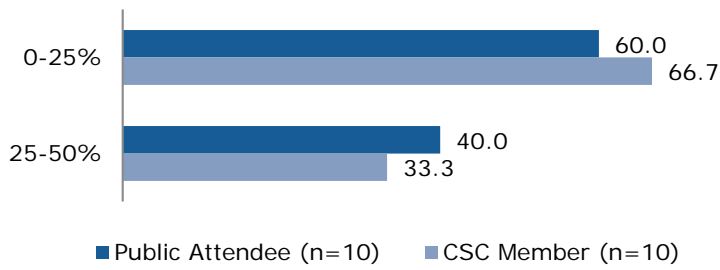

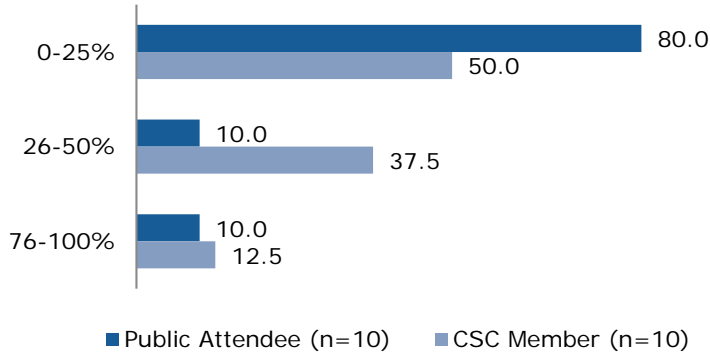

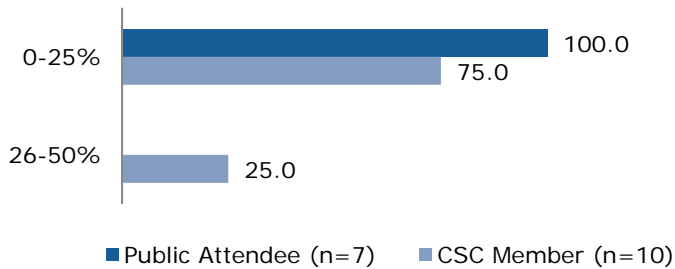

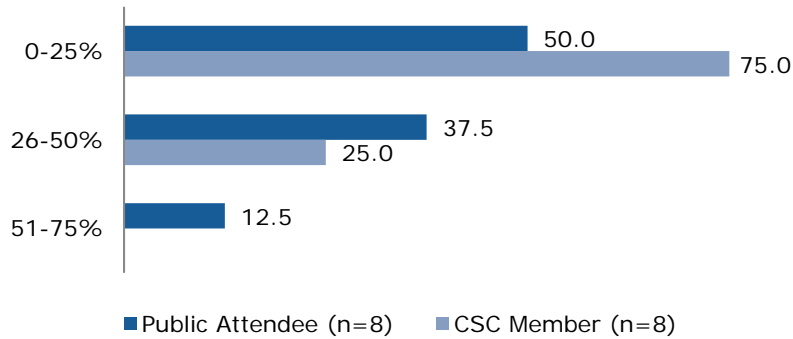
**Exhibit 12. For each of the following mitigation strategies you are in favor of, please select the amount of funding you would like to dedicate for each: *School bus replacement projects***



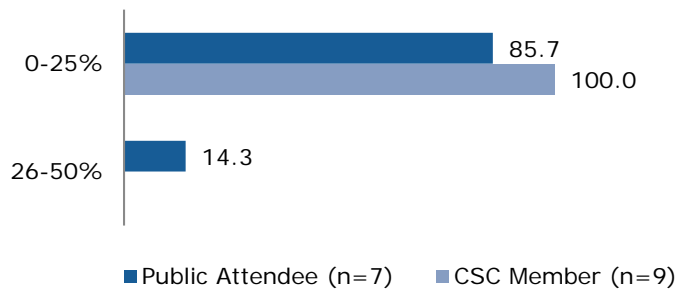

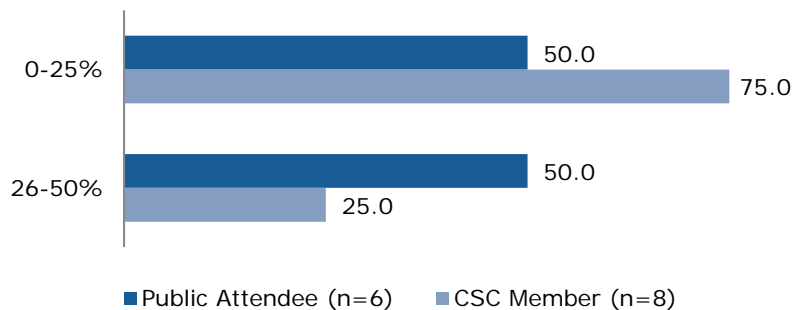
**Exhibit 14.** For each of the following mitigation strategies you are in favor of, please select the amount of funding you would like to dedicate for each: *Green-space projects*
