### **AB 617 Steering Committee Charter**

### Goals

Committee is to receive updates on community air quality monitoring and emission reduction efforts and to provide suggestions to maximize results.

Committee will hear concerns from the public and other stakeholders and alert appropriate parties so action, as warranted, can occur promptly.

### **Committee Bylaws**

- 1. The Co-Chairs will select the members with deference given to suggestions from each of the interest groups.
- The selected parties were diversified to represent different areas within the community. There was an emphasis
  on selecting stakeholders with different types of networks, representing different types of organizations and
  businesses.
- 3. Steering Community members must reside or work within the community corridor (Calexico-Heber-El Centro), as defined by the CAPP Blueprint.
- 4. Committee members should enact on an active participatory conduct, to ensure the best outcome and representation of the community.
- 5. There will be one designated alternate for each committee member.
- 6. Members will serve on a voluntary basis, for a two-year term provided, however, that members may continue to serve until a successor has been appointed.
- 7. Members can be re-appointed.
- 8. Air District and Comite Civico del Valle (CCV) will co-chair the meetings.
- 9. Co-Chairs will be responsible for opening meeting, approving the draft agenda and meeting notes through simple majority, adjust the order of agenda items to help facilitate meetings, and close the meetings.
- 10. Meetings will be held monthly or as appropriate.
- 11. Members will attend all appropriate meetings and other appointments and notify Co-Chairs and their alternate if they cannot make a meeting.
- 12. Meetings will be open to the public.
- 13. IC APCD or its designee will take meeting minutes.
- 14. Co-Chairs will send out a draft agenda and draft minutes from previous meeting at least 7 days prior to the meeting.
- 15. Co-Chairs will accept agenda suggestions up to ten days prior to the meeting.
- 16. Co-Chairs may update the agenda at least three (3) days prior to any meeting.
- 17. All meetings will have time set aside for public comment.
- 18. Public comment may be limited to three (3) minutes per person.
- 19. All meetings will be at a time and location conducive for community involvement.
- 20. IC APCD staff may give an update on community monitoring and emission reductions at each meeting.
- 21. Bylaws will be reviewed and updated as needed on an annual basis.

### **AB 617 Steering Committee Charter**

### Code of conduct:

To ensure mutual and respectful participation all AB 617 Committee members must:

- 1. Be punctual at arriving at the meetings and returning from breaks, respect time limits for agenda items, and plan to stay for the entire meeting.
- 2. Communicate openly, directly, and respectfully.
- 3. Be courteous, listen attentively, and be respectful of other points of view.
- 4. Participate fully in the group exchange, and not engage in sideline conversations, cross-talk, or distracting behaviors.
- 5. Be flexible and open to change and new ideas.
- 6. Stay on task and not divert attention to other unrelated topics.
- 7. Assume positive intentions by others, giving them the benefit of the doubt.
- 8. Strive for consensus in decision making; if an impasse is reached, a simple majority vote will be used. Respect that decision, even if it is not your preference.
- 9. Make decisions based on what is best for the children and families in this community, and not on personal agendas or what is expedient or easy.




