

Community Air Monitoring Update

1. Installation of first community monitor

2. Locations from the Steering Committee
 - i. Port of Entry (East)
 - I. Have a potential host for the East Port of Entry (within distance) which is willing to provide the space for an air quality monitor.
 - ii. Southwest High School
 - I. Student group and administration are working together to receive an air quality monitor.
 - iii. Cesar Chavez & 2nd
 - iv. Dogwood Ave. & HWY 98
 - v. Residences/Park near New River
 - vi. Grand Plaza Outlet
 - vii. Heber Feedlot
 - viii. Enrique Camarena School
 - ix. 4th St & Aurora
 - x. Port of Entry (West)
 - xi. El Centro Water Plant/Walmart Area
 - xii. Imperial Valley Mall
 - xiii. Heber Geothermal
 - xiv. ECRMC Outpatient Center
 - xv. Adams St & Imperial Ave

Proposal:

The highlighted locations are all within 2-mile radius of each other. Installing monitors at multiple locations within this radius would be redundant and we can expand the locations instead to the alternate list which would add:

- Washington Elementary (El Centro)
- Heber Emergency Services (Heber)

This would create greater coverage without saturating one specific location in the corridor. The final decision is left for the Steering Committee to consider the strategy moving forward. As part of the partners in this project, Comite Civico del Valle, Inc. is opening the opportunity for the Steering Committee to move locations per our recommendation.
